Old Business:

- Pickleball preparation is considered minimal. Three inches of topcoat would need to be on pavement. Installation of an 8-foot fence, and two solid walls were discussed to prevent balls from traveling to Trundle Bed Road. The two walls would be built aesthetically pleasing and could be used for other sports, and ice skating.
 - The need to raise money to support this effort was discussed. Embarking on campaign, engaging with the Recreation Committee, and offering donor recognition were part of the conversation. DelSesto agreed to discuss with a landscape architect to determine cost estimates.
- Snack Shack rental was rediscussed. It was agreed that we would use the same RFP as last season.
- Turf Maintenance contract up for renewal for 2023 and 2024. A motion to approve solicitation of vendors by Greenwood, seconded by Bunnell. Passed unanimously.
- Website – GoDaddy will be asked for an estimate to rebuild the website. Bunnell agreed to request the estimate.

New Business:

- Trees and branches fell during the ice storm. The large oak fell over the crosswalk on Trundle Bed Road. It needs to be cut down. The question was raised if the Town is responsible for the work. Bob Soloman agreed to inquire with the Town.

- Exeter Junior Baseball President and KYAA will be reminded to join our meetings. Donna agreed to send the reminder.
- The SKT would like to hold their meetings at the Town Hall. Bob Soloman agreed to make the request and to begin on 2/8/23.
