 - Unutil – \$2,888.25 - total for months of June and July. Park was \$976.64, and the Field was \$528.07 for a total of \$1504.71 for June and park \$743.23, and field was \$643.31 for total of \$1383.54 for July.
 - Home & Planet Cleaning - \$3,910.00 total for June and July. June was \$1895.00 and July was \$2015.00.
