- Erin Angelini, Treasurer, and David Roberge, President of KYAA, discussed the following:
 - A formal application will be forthcoming that will include the teams' schedules. Discussion included:
 - The KYAA Softball/T-Ball will have 1 t-ball team, 1 6U team, 2 8U teams, 1 10U team, and a 12U team.
 - Will request to begin practicing on Saturday, April 12 weather dependent, and opening day on Saturday, April 18.
 - Request will for Fields A (games) and C (practice)
 - Possibly 5 Friday night games for 8U and 10U and 12U teams.
- We discussed Jim Webber's, EJBSL President, email following our January meeting which he attended (see January notes). In his email, he asked the following questions
 - EJBSL purchased a replacement food warmer for the Concession stand
 - In addition to what was discussed, EJBSL would like to rent Field A for night games on some of the evenings when Field B is already lit for baseball games. They would be interested in renting it on a per-game basis plus lighting fees—something like \$125 per night game. They will submit their Field A schedule at the same time as the Field B lighting schedule.
